

## Tibial Tuberosity Advancement (TTA) Course

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### Is there an online lecture for this course?

No, the Tibial Tuberosity Advancement (TTA) course includes a live lecture and hands-on wet lab. It does not have an online lecture.

#### Is this course RACE approved?

Yes. The Comprehensive Tibial Tuberosity Advancement (TTA) 1-Day Course\* has been approved for 9 hours of continuing education credit in jurisdictions which recognize RACE approval.

#### What should I wear?

Attendees should wear attire that is comfortable and cadaver friendly. Securos University will provide plastic aprons, gloves, and masks to protect you and your clothes, but accidents happen. Scrubs are always a good choice.

#### Will I be provided handouts?

Yes. This course includes a live lecture and power point presentation. Attendees will be provided hard copies of the presentation.
